The Finance Minor provides students with more advanced training in the areas of corporate finance, management of financial institution and investment , and prepares students for a potential career in the financial services sector in Hong Kong. Emphasis is placed on both theory and practice relevant to Hong Kong and Asia-Pacific economies. On completion of the minor, students will gain a deep understanding of the environment in which the Hong Kong financial services sector is operating, and the instruments that it uses.

In year 2, students shall take two compulsory courses related to the financial markets and investment. In semester A of year 3, students shall choose one from three courses relevant to Corporate Finance, Investment and Financial Institution. While in semester B of year 3, students shall choose one from four courses relevant to Corporate Finance, Investment, Banking and Capital Markets.
