

BDO (HK) Best Intern Scholarship Award 2014

On 25 April 2014, Fanny Man, a year 2 student majoring in AMIS (BBA3), won the Champion in BDO (HK) Best Intern Scholarship Contest 2014 and got a tentative offer of employment in BDO (HK) upon graduation and HK\$ 5000 cash reward.
