Programme Information

MSc Finance (MSF) programme aims at providing students with advanced knowledge in financial management including financing & investment strategies and risk management.

MSc Financial Engineering (MSFE) programme targets at helping students acquire advanced quantitative skills to analyze sophisticated derivative models, price and evaluate the risk of complex financial instruments, and develop appropriate risk management strategies.

The programmes require students to complete 30 credit units: 24 from 8 required courses and 6 from 2 elective courses. In general, each course carries 3 credit units.

The table on the right lists the required courses (marked \checkmark) and the finance electives (marked *). Students can choose two elective courses (either two finance electives or one finance elective with one other course offered by our Department or other various departments in the College of Business, which suits students' interests and career development needs).

The programmes are offered in combined mode—local students can study full-time or part-time in different semesters without seeking approval from the University. Non-local students have to enroll in the programme either on a full-time or part-time basis depending on their visa status.

Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a bachelor's degree from a recognized university preferably with more than 1 year of work experience in the industry.

For applicants who obtained their bachelor's degree from institutions where the medium of instruction is not English, there is a minimum English proficiency requirement:

- A TOEFL score of 550 (paper-based test) or 79 (internet-based test); or
- An overall band score of 6.5 in International English Language Testing System (IELTS); or
- A score of 490 in the new College English Test (CET-6) of Chinese mainland or a pass in the old CET-6 test; or
- Other equivalent qualifications

TUITION FEE

For September 2019 entry, the tuition fee is HK\$263,700 per programme (30 credit units).

APPLICATION

For September 2019 entry, the admission application period is November 14, 2018 – March 31, 2019. Applications are processed on a rolling basis. Review of applications will start before the deadline and continue until all places are filled. Early applications are therefore strongly encouraged. Applicants who have outstanding academic record in a non-finance major are also welcome to apply.
