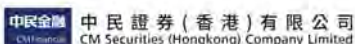

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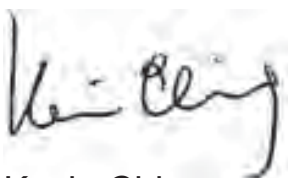
Welcome Message from the Chair

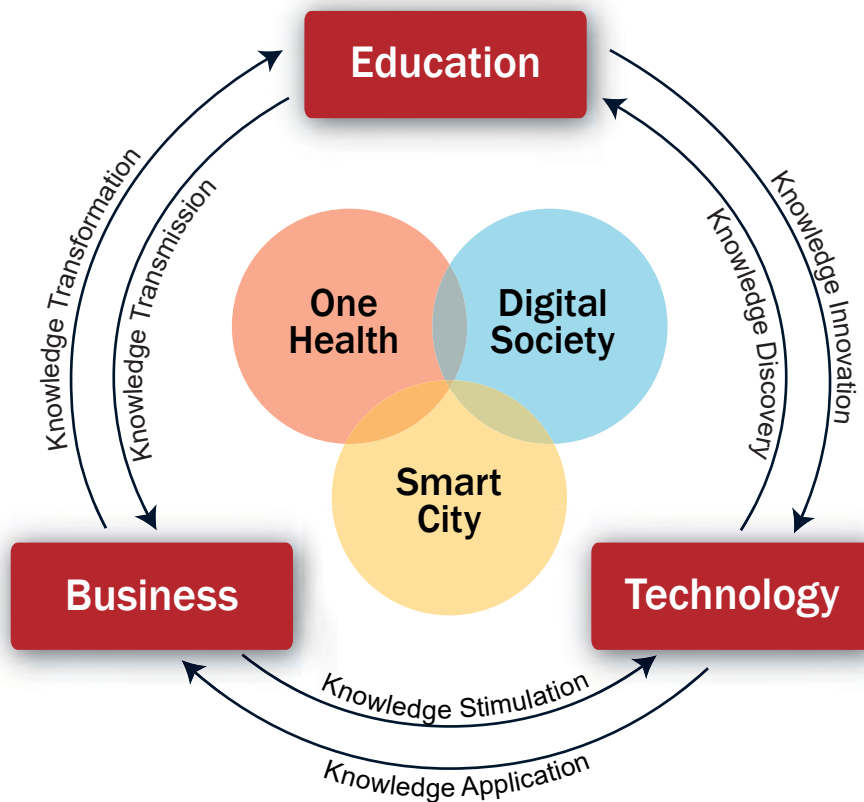

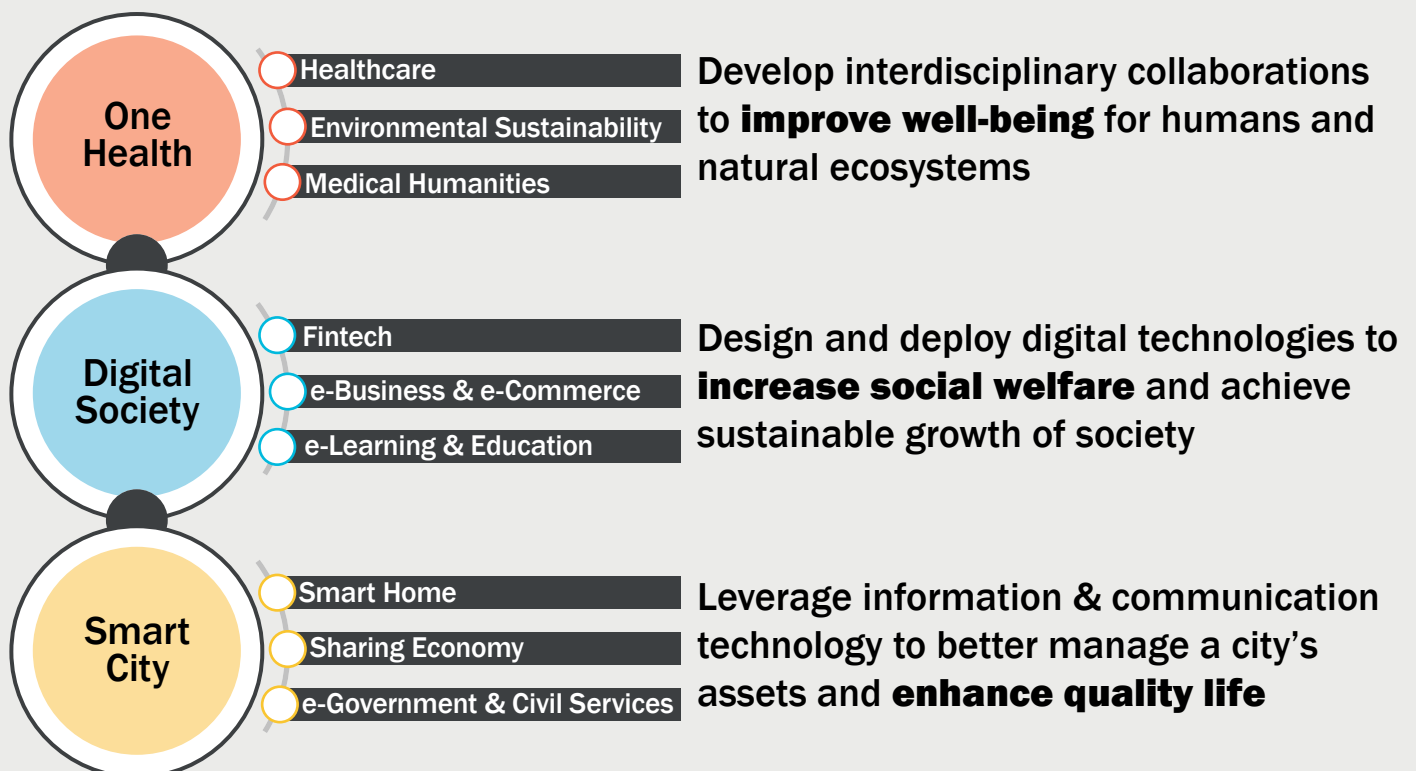

Prof. Way KUO

*President and Distinguished University Professor
City University of Hong Kong*

Professor Way Kuo is President of City University of Hong Kong. He is a member of US National Academy of Engineering, a Member of Academia Sinica, Taiwan, and a Foreign Member of the Chinese Academy of Engineering and Russian Academy of Engineering. He is renowned for his work in system reliability research and is acknowledged as a pioneer in designing and modeling reliability of electronics systems.

Professor Kuo has previously worked in the senior management team for Oak Ridge National Laboratory and served as Dean of Engineering at the University of Tennessee. His popular science book *Critical Reflections on Nuclear and Renewable Energy*, Scrivener-Wiley 2014, has created an impact since its publication in 2013. The book has been translated into English, Japanese, French and Russian. It has also been published in Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Beijing in both traditional and simplified Chinese under different titles.

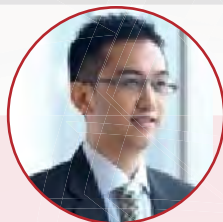
Dr. Witman HUNG, JP

He also served as a member of 11th Standing Committee of the All China Youth Federation. In 2015, he was appointed as a Justice of the Peace by the HKSAR Government.

The connectivity, accessibility, mobility, and smartness inherent to mobile services have bolstered a more closed integration between hospital and home. How will this integration enhance the quality of medical services and facilitate the efficient distribution of medical resources? By exploring the new wave in personal healthcare, this forum will discuss the benefits of mobile healthcare from patients' perspective and the resulting potential changes to a patient's lifestyle.

Currently an incubatee of the Hong Kong Cyberport Incubation Programme, AcesoBee has officially established itself in the professional eHealth community by becoming a registered member of HL7 HK and a certified service provider of the HKSAR eHealth Record CMS On-Ramp Implementation Programme.

Mr. HUI Hing Loi (Chief Systems Manager, Hong Kong Hospital Authority)

Mr. Hui is currently the Chief Systems Manager for Hospital Authority, with responsibility on application and mobile systems architecture and development. While technology could help to optimize work flows and increase efficiency in financial services, it could also create some risks. With the advent of robo-advisors and the continued growth of artificial intelligence (AI) capabilities, certain labor intensive tasks could become obsolete. How does the future path look like and how can we continue to be relevant? Our panel of distinguished speakers will discuss the latest trends in Fintech and Insurtech, as well as AI adoption in the banking sector. They will also provide insights on the new opportunities and risks under the current environment.



Dr. Florian Matthaeus Spiegl (Co-Founder and COO, FinFabrik)

Dr. Florian Matthaeus Spiegl is the Co-Founder and current COO of FinFabrik, a Fintech start-up specialized in capital markets technology. Prior to founding his own start-up, he worked as Vice President and Senior Manager for Credit Suisse in Singapore and Zurich. During that time, he was responsible for the digital strategy in the private banking sector. Before joining in the banking industry, he worked as a consultant for The Boston Consulting Group in Vienna and New York. Parallel to that he was the Director of Birke Travel Solutions, a Viennese online travel agency. Dr. Spiegl is a founding member of the Fintech Association of Hong Kong and holds the Co-Chair of the Artificial Intelligence Committee. He received a PhD in political economics from University of Vienna and an MSc in strategic management and entrepreneurship from Vienna University of Economics and Business.

Dr. Martin Qiao (Lead Architect for Machine Learning, HSBC)

Martin is currently the lead architect for Machine Learning Automation at HSBC, responsible for end-to-end solution architecture design and machine learning technology control. He received a PhD in mathematics from Hong Kong Baptist University, majoring in data mining and imaging science. He is highly experienced in applying statistical modelling and machine learning techniques in business problems from various sectors including high-tech industry, luxury retailing, insurance marketing, banking operations, etc.



Mr. Alvin KWOCK (Founder & CEO, OneDegree)

Mr. Alvin Kwock is the Founder & CEO of OneDegree. OneDegree is a technology company taking insurance to the next generation in Asia. Mr. Kwock is a member of the Future Task Force at Insurance Authority in Hong Kong. He was Asia-Pacific Head of Emerging Technology and Taiwan Head of Research at J.P. Morgan. Under Mr. Kwock's leadership, J.P. Morgan's Asia Tech Hardware team has been consistently rated in the Institutional Investors Poll, Financial Times / Starmine and Asiamoney. He co-founded and captained research effort for the inaugural J.P. Morgan Global TMT Conference in Asia in Nov 2013. He has been invited to present in a number of advisory boards, and as a guest lecturer at National Taiwan University. He has co-founded an Augmented Reality start-up and served in the capacity of Chief Business Officer. Mr. Kwock holds a MA degree in Social Science and a BA degree in Economics, both from the University of Chicago.

Dr. Seen-Meng Chew (Adjunct Professor, City University of Hong Kong)
