It was an in-line survey performed by an independent market research company from October to December 2017.

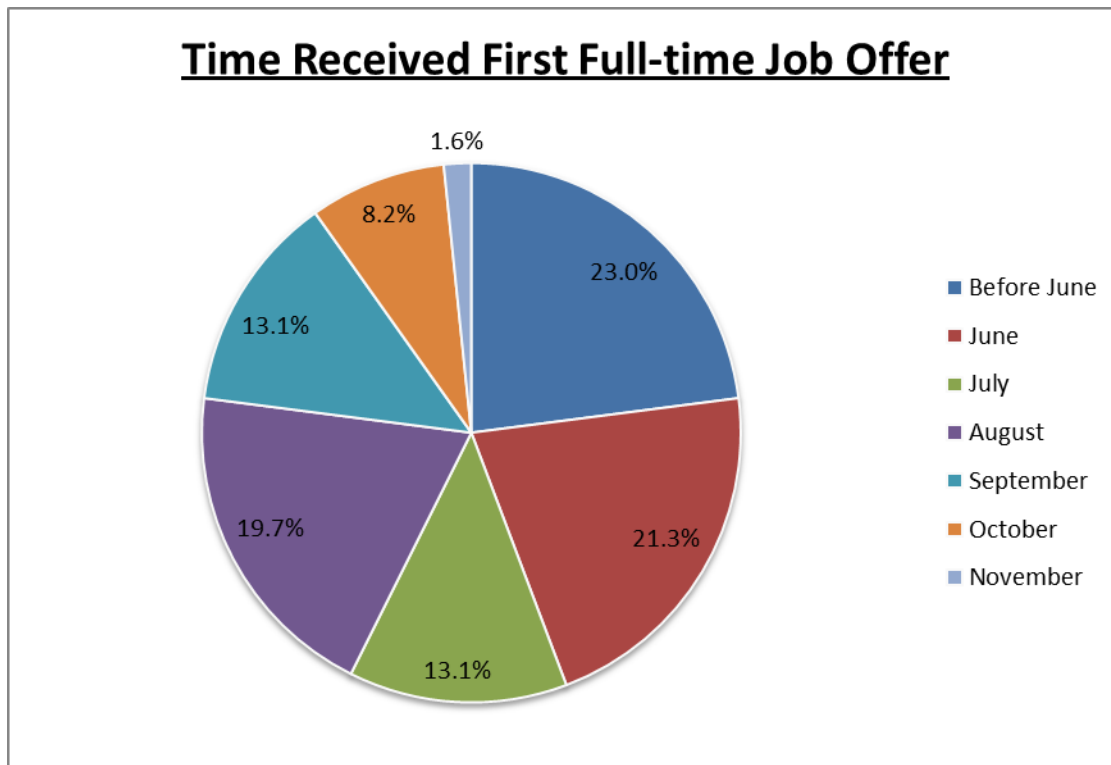

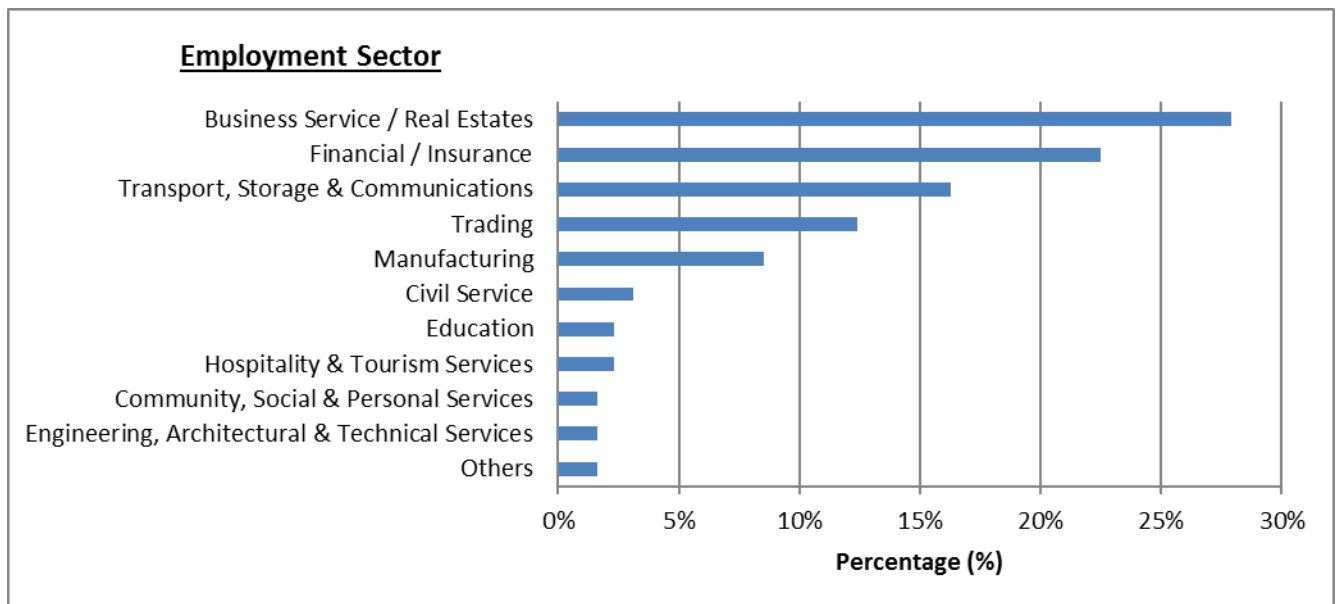
