I am pleased to announce that the National Taiwan University will join City University of Hong Kong in the publication of the *Asia-Pacific Journal of Accounting and Economics (APJAE)* starting from the year 2007 and that Professor Hong Hwang of National Taiwan University, a renowned scholar, will join me as Co-Editor of the journal and run a separate editorial office in Taipei. We are now also in the process of setting up a North American editorial office for the journal.

As a result of the collaboration, *APJAE* will begin publishing three issues a year starting 2007. The new plan will see a new issue of *APJAE* published every April, August and December.

Inaugurated in 1994, the journal has since won substantial support among researchers in the Asia-Pacific region and throughout the world. I would like to thank the National Taiwan University for all their support and assistance in this collaboration. I look forward to working closely with Professor Hwang, the newly appointed and existing editorial members in bringing *APJAE* to a new height.
