Call for Papers

A symposium sponsored by *Asia-Pacific Journal of Accounting and Economics (APJAE)* will be held in Honolulu, Hawaii on December 18-19, 2008. The symposium is organized by the Department of Accounting of National Taiwan University, Department of Accountancy of the City University of Hong Kong, the School of Accountancy of the University of Hawaii, University of Hawaii Center for International Business Education and Research, and the Pacific Asian Consortium for International Business Education and Research (www.PACIBER.org). We welcome papers in any academic field within accounting, such as financial accounting, managerial accounting, auditing, accounting information systems and international accounting. Papers submitted for the Symposium should contain unpublished original research.

The papers accepted for presentation in the Symposium will be regarded as submissions to the *Asia-Pacific Journal of Accounting and Economics (APJAE)*. The papers, subject to a refereeing and selection process, will be scheduled for future publication in the regular issues of *APJAE* or a special *APJAE* symposium issue in 2009. Professors Shirley J. Daniel and Shu-hsing Li, the conference coordinators, will be Guest Editors for the special issue.
