Dr. Wong obtained his Ph.D. degree in Mathematics from the University of California, Berkeley. After teaching at the University of California, Davis for a short period of time, he moved to the private sector as a consultant. While serving as the Principal Architect in a State of California government data center, he received the Distinguished Services Award from the California Government for his contribution to complex information system design work.

He returned to Mainland China in 1982 and has served as a consultant in a number of state-operated organizations. He contributed to the design and development of indigenous computer hardware and software in China in the 1980s. He returned to Hong Kong in 1987 and founded the first iASPEC company the following year.

Dr. Wong is a Distinguished Fellow of the Hong Kong Computer Society. He received the Medal of Honor and the Bronze Bauhinia Star from the HKSAR government in 2014 and 2023 respectively.
