

MScPACG: Leadership Training Camp



The Department of Accountancy organized a Leadership Training Camp on 17 June 2023, for the students of the Master of Science in Professional Accounting and Corporate Governance (MScPACG). The training camp aimed to help the students build trust when working in a team, enhance their communication skills and team spirit, and challenge themselves.



Nineteen students from the MScPACG programme participated in the training camp, which was held at the Wong Siu Sang Leadership Training Centre (WSSLTC), Sha Tsui, Hebe Haven, Sai Kung. The full-day training camp was run and facilitated by the Scout Association of Hong Kong. A variety of experiential teaching methods were used, including structured group activities, leadership tasks, and high and low element challenge courses.

The training camp kicked off with ice breaker games. The students were divided into groups and asked to set their goals for the day. The groups were engaged in several team challenges that focused on communication, problem-solving, conflict resolution, teamwork, and self-challenge. After completion of the challenges, the students sat down with their facilitators to review and reflect on what they had learned throughout the day.

The Department hopes that the students were able to have fun and at the same time learned valuable skills through this experiential leadership training camp that can be applied in their daily life as well as future professional career.
