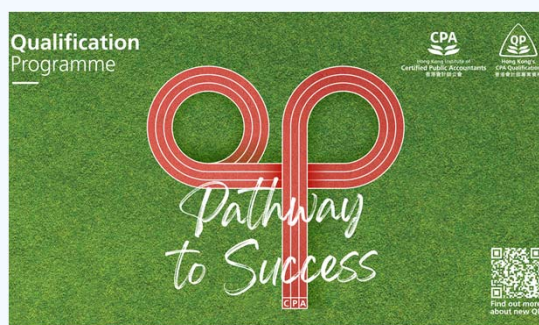


## HKICPA Sharing Session – Theme: Clarification of the Myths of the Accounting Profession



The Department of Accountancy (AC) organized an information sharing session on 6 February 2024 targeted towards all AC undergraduate and postgraduate students with the aim of clarifying myths related to the accounting profession.

Mr. Jason Ko, Manager of Education and Training at the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA), was invited to hold the information session about commonly held misconceptions related to the accounting profession. Mr. Ko is a Fellow of the HKICPA who joined the organization in 2019 and is currently engaged in the HKICPA Qualification Programme (QP) operation and development aspects.
