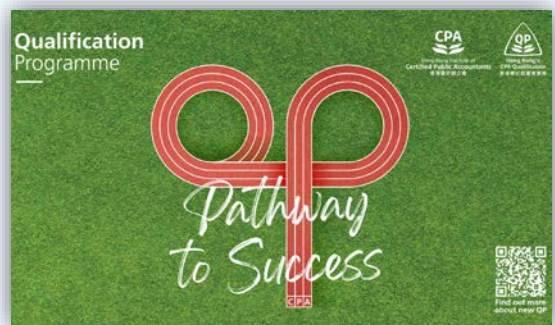


HKICPA Sharing Session – Theme: Clarification of the Myths of the Accounting Profession



The Department of Accountancy (AC) held an information sharing session on 6 February 2024 that targeted all AC undergraduate and postgraduate students. The aim of the session was to clarify myths related to the accounting profession.

Mr. Jason Ko, Manager of Education and Training at the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA), was invited to host this session, which examined commonly held misconceptions related to the accounting profession. Mr. Ko is a Fellow of the HKICPA who joined the organization in 2019 and is currently engaged in operations and development aspects of the HKICPA Qualification Programme (QP).
