The City University of Hong Kong (CityU) Department of Accountancy has ranked first in the Peking University HSBC Business School (PHBS) 2022 ranking (PHBS 50 ranking) in the Accountancy category in the Greater China area in the recent five years. The ranking is based on the number of publications in the top 5 accounting journals namely *The Accounting Review (TAR)*, *Journal of Accounting Research (JAR)*, *Contemporary Accounting Research (CAR)*, *Review of Accounting Studies (RAST)* and *Journal of Accounting and Economics (JAE)*.

The Department has topped the ranking in the recent five years with 35 papers published in those five years in the above-mentioned top accounting journals. It shows that the Department has been performing exceptionally in publishing research work in top accounting journals. Among the key topics explored in the research work were Voluntary Disclosure, Merger and Acquisition, Management Forecast, Corporate Governance, Earnings Management, Audit Quality, Tax Avoidance, Litigation Risk, Real Effects and Executive Compensation.

The Department strives to continue producing high-quality research work and successfully publishes in top accounting journals to make a meaningful impact and contribute towards the study of Accountancy.
