

Congratulations to Prof. Raymond Wong on Receiving the AI Innovation in Education Award

The Department of Accountancy (AC) is pleased to announce that a paper by Prof. Raymond Wong entitled “Developing an AI Platform to Promote University Students’ Reflective Capacity” received the AI Innovation in Education Award at the International Conference on Open and Innovation Education (ICOIE 2026), held on 23–24 July 2026.

The award-winning paper is a key output of a Fund for Innovative Technology-in-Education project (HK\$300,000), awarded in late 2023 and now in its concluding year. Prof. Wong presented the study at ICOIE 2026 and published it in the conference proceedings. The publication has also been recorded in the CityUHK Scholars repository as “RGC Category 32 – Refereed conference paper (with host publication) (Type: A)”.

ICOIE 2026 marks the conference’s 13th edition and attracted over 200 submissions from more than 25 countries and territories, reflecting strong international interest in open, innovative, and technology-enhanced education. According to the conference’s award description, the AI Innovation in Education Award recognises “the most groundbreaking and impactful use of artificial intelligence to enhance teaching and learning”, aligning directly with the conference theme.



Prof. Wong worked closely with project collaborators, including Co-PIs from three other universities, HKUST (lead), PolyU, and Lingnan University, and is honoured to receive this recognition. He also expressed gratitude for the support and insightful advice provided by CityUHK, particularly AC’s support for the conference presentation, throughout the project implementation.
