This course will not be counted towards the minimum credit units required for graduation and will not be included in the calculation of CGPA. However, it will be counted towards the maximum credit units permitted. (b) First-year intake students with Level 4 or above in HKDSE Chinese OR Grade D or above in HKALE AS in Chin. Lang. & Culture are NOT required to take CHIN1001. (c) First-year intake students other than (a) and (b), including mainland and non-local students are NOT required to take CHIN1001.
