Department of Accountancy - Internship Awards for Master of Arts in International Accounting (MAIA)

Regulations

The Department of Accountancy has agreed to establish awards from its Non-UGC Reserves for the new intakes of Master of Arts in International Accounting (MAIA) students with effect from the academic year 2018/2019 under the following regulations:

1. The Awards shall be known as the “Department of Accountancy - Internship Awards for MA International Accounting”.
2. There shall be a maximum of SIX awards per annum. The value of each awards shall be HK\$3,000.
3. Students who have completed and fulfilled all the course requirements of AC6780 Professional Internship with outstanding performance may be considered and nominated for the awards.
4. Nominations from the Department of Accountancy shall reach the Student Development Services by the end of June / September 2019 and the awards shall then be made as earlier as possible. The Department of Accountancy reserves the right to make final decision on the nominations.
5. Confirmation will be sought from the Department of Accountancy before July of each year on whether or not the Scholarships will be continued for the following academic year.

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.
