The Department of Accountancy Mainland Outbound Exchange Awards

Regulations

Commencing 2007/2008 academic year, the Department of Accountancy has established an award scheme “The Department of Accountancy Mainland Outbound Exchange Awards” by using the available funding in the Non-UGC Reserves (Departmental). The following regulations shall apply as of 2017/2018:

- (1) *The Awards shall be known as “The Department of Accountancy Mainland Outbound Exchange Awards”.*
- (2) *Eligibility*
The Awards shall be offered to undergraduate students enrolling in the Department of Accountancy’s academic programme and have met the following criteria:
 - (i) *Have been selected to participate in one of the Departmental level exchange programmes to mainland universities; and*
 - (ii) *Awardees are required to enroll at the host institutions an equivalent of at least 12 credit units as defined in City University of Hong Kong. Failure to fulfill this credit requirement will result in the withdrawal of the awards.*
- (3) *Award Value and Number of Awards*
 - (i) *A maximum of **THREE** awards will be available for each academic year.*
 - (ii) *The value of each award shall be HK\$3,000, payable on or before the end of September for Semester A awards of the academic year and on or before the end of January for Semester B awards of the academic year.*
- (4) *Obligation of the Award Recipients*
 - (i) *Awardees are required to be CityU-AC’s student exchange ambassadors. They are expected to promote the image of the University and Department in the host institutions.*
 - (ii) *On their return, they are required to (a) share their experience with fellow students in Department of Accountancy’s website; (b) be student advisors to future in-bound and out-bound exchange students; and (c) submit a report of at least 500 words with photos on their one-semester studies at host University to the Department of Accountancy within 2 months after they return from the exchange programme.*
- (5) *Application and Selection Process*
 - (i) *Students will be asked to apply for the Awards in November and May respectively. Nominations made by the Department of Accountancy shall reach the Student Development Services on or before the end of August for Semester A awards of the academic year and on or before the end of December for Semester B awards of the academic year.*

- (ii) *Selection criteria are primarily on academic merits. Candidates with achievements in other areas such as recipients of outstanding academic awards, active participation in extra-curricular activities, community and social services, etc. may receive higher priorities.*
- (6) *The Department of Accountancy reserves the right to withhold the number of nominees.*
- (7) *The Awards shall be offered annually until further notice is received from the Department of Accountancy.*

Remarks

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term will be incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.

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
