

Tertiary cup rickshaw team at ACCA Community Day 2018

ACCA Hong Kong hosted its 21st Community Day at Chater Road Sunday Pedestrian Zone, Central, on 28 January 2018. The event brought together hundreds of participants from accountancy firms, multinational companies, corporations, and institutions.
