
<u>New Double Bachelor's Degree Programme – Bachelor of Laws and Bachelor of Business Administration in Accountancy</u>



Semester A 2022/2023 will see the launch of a double degree programme by the Department of Accountancy (AC). The Bachelor of Laws and Bachelor of Business Administration in Accountancy will be delivered over five years and will provide students with qualifications in law and accountancy. Students will acquire wide-ranging legal knowledge and skills that will enable them to progress to professional legal training, and will also develop foundational knowledge that will assist them in qualifying as accountants. Learning and teaching will be interactive and aligned with intended learning outcomes.

Students will enrol in a number of accounting courses offered by the AC and law courses from the School of Law in all semesters of the five-year programme to complete a minimum requirement of 150 credits (including 54 credits in accounting and business courses and 54 credits in law courses). The graduates of the double degree programme will benefit from a rigorous legal education combined with solid academic training in accounting within a global business mindset. It is thus expected that they will be highly sought after for positions in the commercial and financial sectors.
