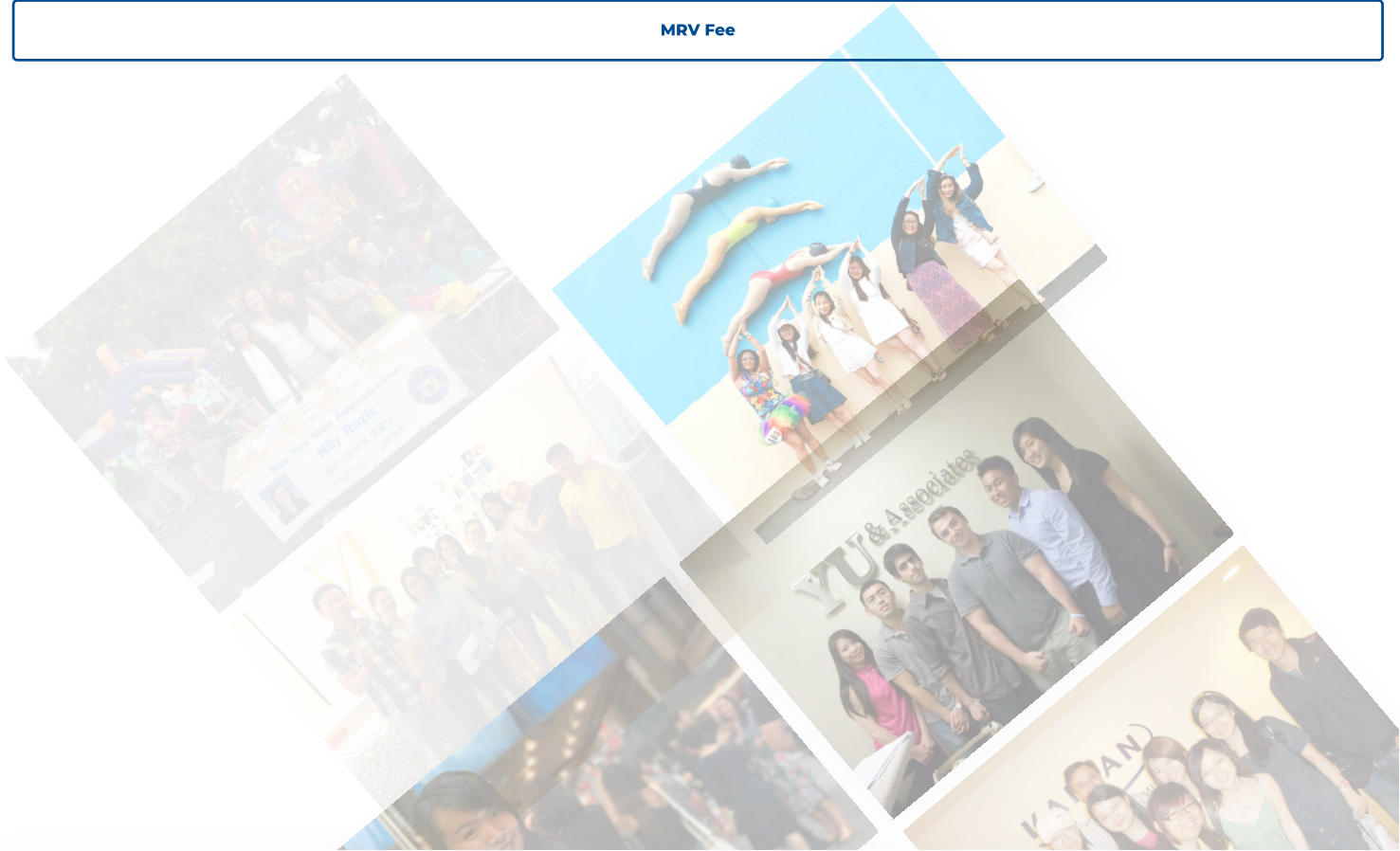

Program fees at a glance

- USD 130 per room/night / 2 students
- Hotel taxes and breakfasts included
- Room type: Standard double

Other estimates

Initial expenses (estimates)

In addition to our program fee, we recommend budgeting for additional expenses, such as airfare, cell service, and living expenses.

- USD 1500+ airfare (round trips)
- USD 30+ monthly mobile services
- USD 20+ or 840 (6 wk)/1400 (10 wk) living expenses
- USD 1500+ readily accessible emergency funds

NOTE: For airfare, we suggest setting aside at least USD 1500 or more for round-trip travel. Monthly mobile services may cost USD 30+ and living expenses can be estimated at USD 20+ per day. It's also important to have emergency funds readily accessible.

Please keep in mind that actual expenses may vary based on personal circumstances, so it's a good idea to budget conservatively and adjust as needed. Please note that the expenses may vary depending on the situation, and we recommend adjusting accordingly.
