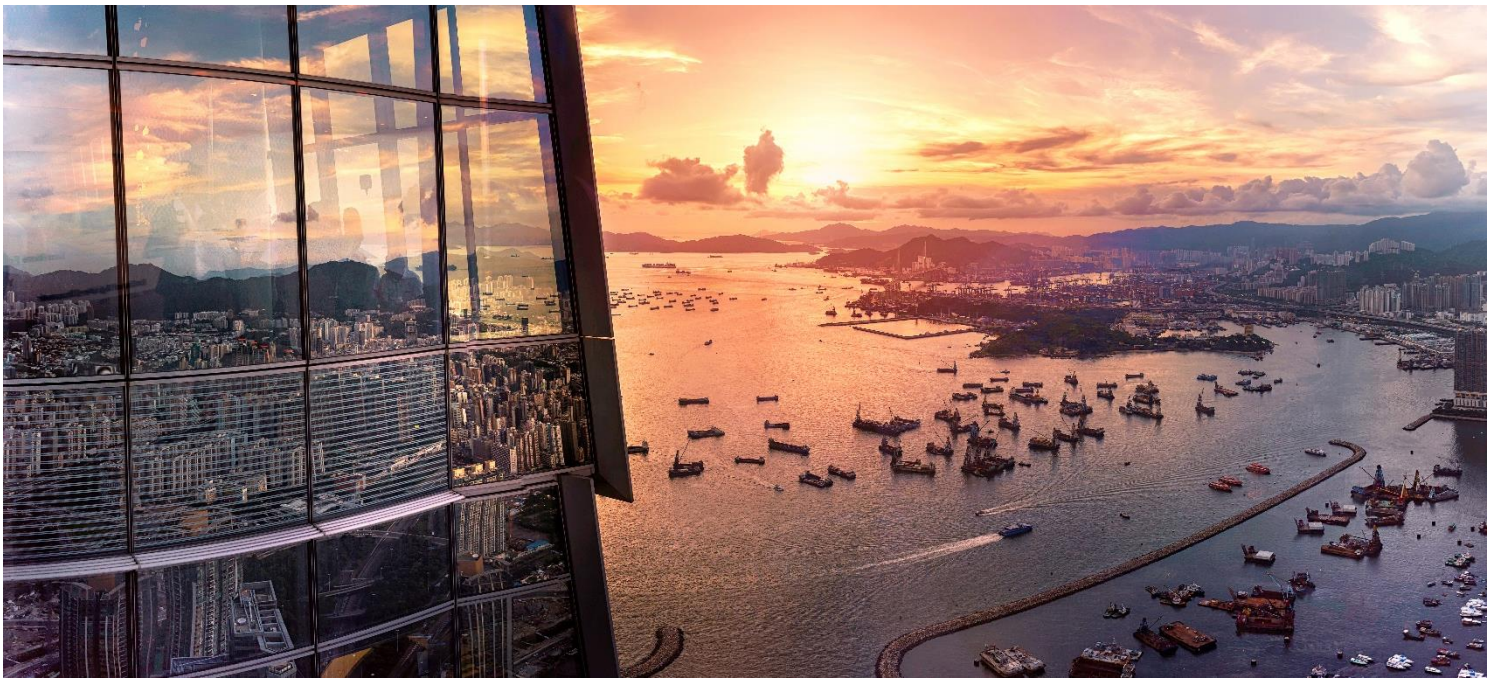

Frequently Asked Questions

Who can register for this competition?

The competition is open only to all undergraduates from any of the universities based in Singapore and Hong Kong. Full-time postgraduate students from local universities, colleges or institutes of vocational education etc., are not eligible to enter the competition.

How many members can a team consist of?

Each team must consist of exactly four members to be able to participate. Unfortunately, we are not able to find a team for individual sign-ups.

Can I team up with participants from other universities?

Yes, your team can include students from different universities within Singapore and Hong Kong. However, teams with members from both cities are not allowed.

Can I team up with participants from other years of study?

Yes, your team can include students across all years of undergraduate study, including freshmen.
