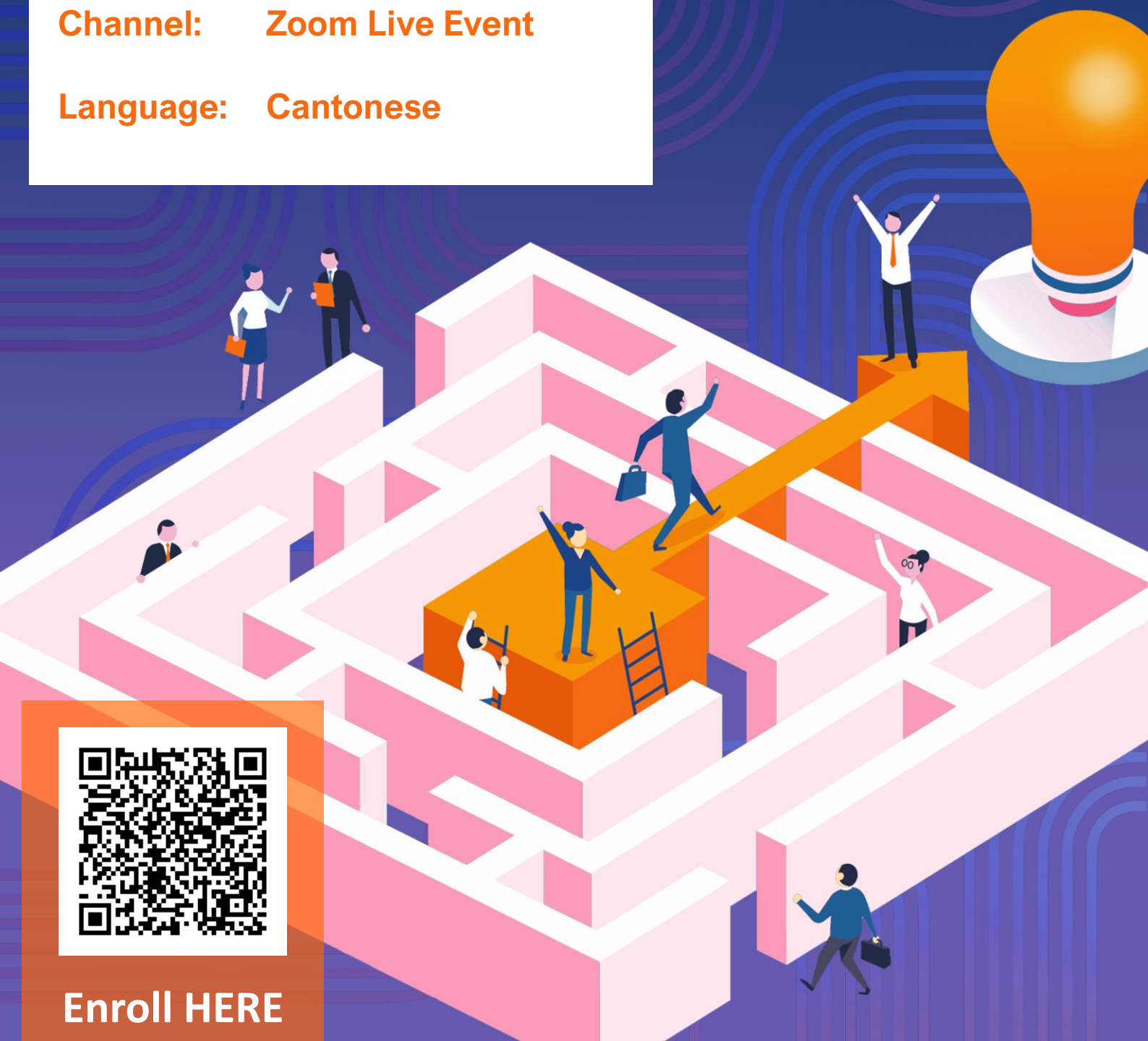

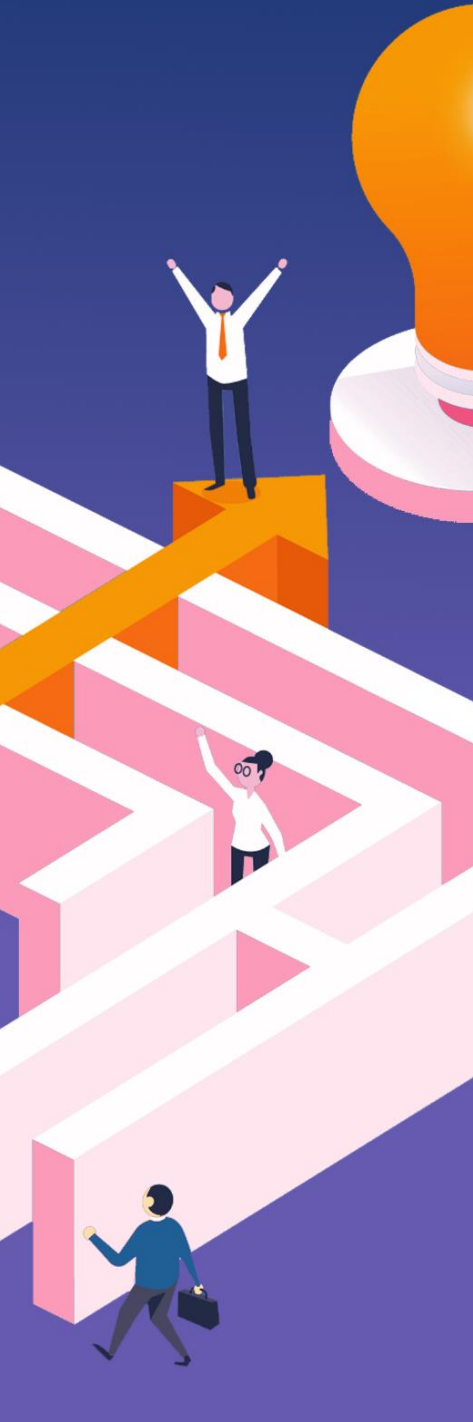
Gigi Tung

Ms Gigi Tung Oi-lai is the founder of Bo Charity Foundation, which launched the food rescue and food assistance programme Food Angel in 2011. Driven by its mission "Waste Not, Hunger Not, With Love", Food Angel rescues edible surplus food from local food suppliers every week and turns it into over 10,000 nutritious hot meals for underprivileged communities across Hong Kong. The Foundation is also committed to education and organises different activities to help raise public awareness on food waste, hunger and poverty issues.

董愛麗女士為小寶慈善基金創辦人，並帶領基金在2011年開展「惜食堂」食物回收及援助計劃，宗旨為「停止浪費、解決飢餓、以愛相連」。「惜食堂」團隊每週向本地飲食界回收仍可安全食用之剩餘食物，並製作超過一萬份營養均衡的熱飯餐，免費派發給社會上需要援助的群體。基金同時致力於教育工作，通過舉辦不同活動，提升社會大眾對食物浪費、環保、飢餓與貧窮問題的關注。
