Information Related to the Sports Hall Incident

On 20 May 2016, the roof of part of the Sports Hall at City University of Hong Kong (CityU) collapsed. Noone present at the venue at the time of the incident sustained any major injuries. Following the incident, the University set up an investigation committee to conduct a thorough inspection of nearby campus facilities. While the preliminary inspection is expected to be completed by 6 June 2016, the facilities that were closed off immediately after the roof collapse are now reopening. We don't envisage that the incident will affect the upcoming 2016 Annual Conference in International Finance. The University has taken all the necessary measures to ensure the health and safety of its visitors, students and staff.
