- The Student Exchange Programme (SEP) was started in 1996.
- Exchange institutions in 6 continents around the world, partnering with renowned overseas universities.
- Established to expose our undergraduate students to MUCH broader learning experiences.











- To train you to become highly motivated, proactive and independent learners and problem-solvers
- Enable you to practice and improve your language proficiency in the local language (or acquire the basics of a new language)
- Help you to deepen your understanding, sensitivity and appreciation of cultural diversities, and enhance your cross-cultural competencies
- Broaden your global outlook and knowledge of different economic, political and social systems















- CB encourages and facilitates students to successfully go on exchange and not to create barriers and prevent them from achieving this goal
- CB nominates students to study abroad through the College Level Exchange Programme and Departmental Exchange Programme and also select suitable candidates to apply for Institutional Level Exchange Programme.

- You would be registered as not-for-degree visiting or exchange students in the overseas universities
- The courses to be taken in the overseas universities must be:
 - relevant to your majors and minors enrolled in CityU
 - approved by your academic advisor and the target university
- Credits earned in the overseas universities will be transferred back to CityU
- Failure of two or more courses will automatically trigger notification to student's Head of Department and Major Leader
- You should not finish all your BBA/BSc programme required credits prior to your exchange study
- You must return to CityU on completion of the exchange period

Student Exchange Fund (for UGC students)

Amount of sponsorship depends on region:

Maximum HK\$24,000 for one semester (local students only)

70% of the funding will be released before your departure

30% of the funding will be released

on condition that you pass a minimum of 4 courses as shown on your transcript from overseas and fulfill all the requirements as stipulated by CityU or CB

Special Fund for Non-local Outbound Exchange Students

Maximum HK\$10,000 for one semester (non-local students only)

70% of the funding will be released before your departure 30% of the funding will be released

on condition that you pass a minimum of 4 courses as shown on your transcript from overseas and fulfill all the requirements as stipulated by CityU or CB

You must have:


Programme

- Min. CGPA 2.8
 (after exam result of Summer 2021)
- Submitted IELTS or TOEFL result on or before 31 July 2021



IELTS scores of minimum 6.5 are required



- A recent passport-sized photo
- IELTS or TOEFL's score report
- Any other supplementary information which you think would be relevant to your application
- Reflect deeply in answering the questions in the "Applicant Statement"
- Study Plan for your target university
- 1-minute Video of Self-Introduction or Introduction of campus facilities & services







Applicant Statement

Think and reflect deeply and analytically

- Understand yourself: Who are you? What are your aspirations, strengths and achievements, areas for development, etc? What do you expect to gain from the experience? Why do you think you are a suitable candidate for SEP?
- Understand your objectives for studying abroad: why do you want to participate in the SEP and what do you hope to learn? What are your plans? How have you prepared for this experience?
- Write clearly and check your English!







Application Procedures



- (i) College & Departmental Level Exchange Programmes (select a max. of ten target countries and universities)
- (ii) If you receive no offer, you will be nominated to apply for the Institutional Level Exchange Programmes (select four universities)


