SP is worth joining

- Low programme fee
 - -CityU subsidizes up to 60%
- Extra funding: SSE, SSEBR
 - -for eligible students | programmes
 - -means | non-means tested
 - -HK\$5,100 to \$19,000
- Additional scholarships
 - -limited quota | merit based
 - -HK\$5,000 to \$10,000





Students awarded extra funding/scholarship

2019: **62** out of 159 (40%)

2021: **22** out of **22** (100%)

2022: **56** out of **66** (85%)

2023: **75** out of **99** (78%)

2024: **78** out of **119** (66%)

- Final year students have to graduate on or after 2 Oct 2025
- CALIS-Plus | CALIS-Pro | SA | RA requires a valid* IELTS score of
 6.0 or above latest by 14 March
 2025

(apply with a valid IELTS score to enjoy admission priority!)

*test date on or after 14 Jan 2023 (21 Jun 23 for SA-Harvard)




