
2018 Management Accounting Best Doctoral Dissertation Award from the American Accounting Association and the 2018 Best Paper Award from the American Accounting Association MAS Midyear Meeting

Dr. Eunhee Kim joined the City University of Hong Kong last July 2017 after she graduated from Carnegie Mellon University. Since joining CityU, she has received two awards: the 2018 Management Accounting Best Doctoral Dissertation Award from the American Accounting Association and the 2018 Best Paper Award from the American Accounting Association MAS Midyear Meeting. Thanks to the generous financial support she received from CityU, she was able to attend both award ceremonies, one of them in Washington DC and the other in Arizona.

Dr. Eunhee Kim conducts accounting research based on an analytical approach that involves developing economic models and verifying conjectures using mathematical proofs. Although her research methodology is relatively uncommon in the field of Accounting, she believes that a methodology is simply a convenient tool to communicate the gist of a research idea. She feels that the message presented by a research paper is more important than the methodology applied. She is extremely grateful that her research has been recognized and that she has been able to pursue the work she believes in.
