**THE PRIZE:** The Board of Trustees of the American Chamber of Commerce Charitable Foundation will select and purchase a book of enduring value and appropriate theme. The American Chamber of Commerce in Hong Kong (AmCham HK) will rebind the book, emboss it with the AmChm HK logo and affix a tasteful certificate of achievement on the inside cover. In addition, the student will also receive a check for HK\$1,000.

**WHO MAY QUALIFY:** In the opinion of school administrators, the student should be in the "*next to graduating class who combine excellence in scholarship with achievement in other fields*". The Headmaster or College Administrator shall be invited to nominate an eligible candidate for the award together with the attached nomination form or a letter of recommendation which is to be sent to: The Chairman, AmCham Charitable Foundation, c/o The American Chamber of Commerce in Hong Kong, 1904, Bank of America Tower, 12 Harcourt Road, Central, Hong Kong.
