





### AIA Foundation Scholarship 2001/2002 Agreement


AIA Foundation ("the Donor") has decided to grant two scholarships ("Scholarship") to the undergraduate students of City University of Hong Kong ("University") for the 2001/2002 Academic Year. Terms and conditions governing the award of the Scholarship are listed below:

1. The Scholarship is named "AIA Foundation Scholarship" and in Chinese "友邦慈善基金獎學金".
2. The value of the Scholarship shall be the equivalent of HK\$15,000 per student for the 2001/2002 Academic Year.
3. The Scholarship shall be awarded to two second-year full-time students ("the Scholar") studying degree courses in any department.
4. The University should recommend at least five candidates for the two scholarships. That is at least one candidate from each Division. The Scholarship shall be awarded to two students to be selected by the Donor.
5. All students nominated by the University should be Hong Kong permanent residents and must attend an interview organized by the Donor.
6. The Donor reserves the right to request the University to re-nominate new candidates if no qualified scholar can be selected from the shortlisted candidates provided by the University.
7. The Scholar can receive other scholarships from other donors.
8. The students nominated should have achieved excellent academic achievement in their previous academic year (i.e. GPA over 3.0).
9. The students nominated should also demonstrate a high sense of belonging to, genuine support for and active participation in community service.
10. The financial background of the students nominated will be taken into consideration under keen competition.
11. Each candidate should complete an application form prepared by the Donor.
12. The Donor may have some related promotion materials relating to AIA Foundation which the University agrees to distribute on behalf of the Donor.
13. Representatives from the Donor should have the right to attend and present the Scholarship in a scholarship presentation ceremony initiated and organized by the University.
14. The Donor reserves its right to rescind the Scholarship granted to any Scholars in case of proven unethical/bias/unfair occurrence in the selection process.
15. All nominations should be forwarded to AIA Foundation on or before December 17, 2001.
