Selection Criteria

- Outstanding academic achievement in postgraduate studies.
- For Thomas H C Cheung Postgraduate Scholarship: Particular quality in leadership, community contribution and financial needs will be taken into account.
- For Postgraduate Scholarship in Humanities or Arts in memory of the late Madam Kao Jan Yun Bor: Nominees should undertake postgraduate degree programmes in the studies or research in humanities or arts.

In view of the limited number of awards, please nominate no more than **one** student for each of the Scholarships.
