MSCOSCM Merit Awards & MSCOSCM Outstanding Student Prizes

Regulations

The Department of Management Sciences has agreed to use funding from the Non-UGC Reserves (Departmental) to establish the MSCOSCM Merit Awards with effect from 2006/2007 academic year and MSCOSCM Outstanding Student Prizes with effect from 2007/2008 academic year. The following regulations shall apply as of 2020/2021:

- 1. Two categories of awards shall be offered annually. The “MSCOSCM Merit Awards” shall be awarded to a maximum of 10 students who, for the first time in their whole study period, have acquired 15 credits or more and who have demonstrated merits in terms of academic achievement. The “MSCOSCM Outstanding Student Prizes” shall be awarded to a maximum of 10 students who, for the first time in their whole study period, have acquired 24 credits or more and who have achieved a CGPA of 3.7 or above. The awards may be given out at the completion of any semester.*
- 2. The total amount of awards for each category in a given year will not exceed HK\$25,000. The values of each award may vary from year to year. The amount of each award shall be HK\$5,000 in maximum.*
- 3. The MSCOSCM programme committee will select the students to be given the awards and the Department of Management Sciences will forward details of the recipients to the Student Development Services by the end of August each year.*
- 4. Confirmation will be sought from the Department of Management Sciences before September each year on whether or not the awards will be continued for the following academic year.*

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008
