MScBDA (QAB) Outstanding Student Award

Regulations

The Department of Management Sciences of the City University of Hong Kong offers Outstanding Student Awards to students within the Quantitative Analysis for Business (QAB) stream of the Master of Science in Business and Data Analytics programme. These awards have been made available through the funding from the departmental Non-UGC Reserves with effect from the academic year 2020/2021. The following regulations shall apply:

1. *The award shall be known as the MScBDA (QAB) Outstanding Student Award.*
2. *The award shall be offered annually. There shall be a maximum of 10 awards each year. The award scheme consists of 2 levels: Gold and Silver. The value of each of the Gold and Silver awards shall not exceed HK\$10,000 and HK\$4,000 respectively with the total amount of the awards not exceeding HK\$50,000.*
3. *To be eligible for the award, a student must be enrolled in the Quantitative Analysis for Business (QAB) stream of the Master of Science in Business and Data Analytics programme.*
4. *Students are selected on the basis of academic performance at the completion of the programme.*
5. *The MScBDA program committee will select the students to be given the awards. The Department of Management Sciences will forward details of the recipients to the Student Development Services by August of each year.*
6. *The recipient is required to write a statement of at least 200 words to share his/her education experience with fellow MScBDA students and university faculty to enhance learning and teaching to the Department of Management Sciences.*
7. *Confirmation will be sought from the Department of Management Sciences before September of each year on whether the awards will be continued for the following academic year.*

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008
