The Department of Management Sciences Outstanding Students Prizes and Scholarship

Regulations

The Department of Management Sciences of the City University of Hong Kong offers Outstanding Students Scholarships to undergraduate students with demonstrated outstanding performance. These scholarships have been made available through the department's Non-UGC Reserve fund with effect from the academic year 1999/2000. The following regulations shall apply as of 2020/2021:

1. *The Scholarship shall be known as the "The Department of Management Sciences Outstanding Students Prizes and Scholarship".*
2. *There shall be a maximum of 15 awards. The value of each award will vary from year to year and shall be HK\$5,000 to HK\$10,000. The maximum amount of the funds in a given year will not exceed HK\$100,000.*
3. *The Scholarships shall be awarded to full-time 1st major Year 2 to Year 4 students from the undergraduate programmes offered by the Department of Management Sciences.*
4. *Students are selected based on the following criteria:*
 - i) *academic performance in Year 2 and/or Year 3;*
 - ii) *participation and achievement in extracurricular activities; and*
 - iii) *demonstration of leadership.*
5. *The Management Sciences Departmental Executive Committee will select the students to receive the scholarships.*
6. *Nomination from the Department of Management Sciences shall reach the Student Development Services by the end of June each year.*
7. *Confirmation on the renewal of the awards for the following academic year will be sought from the Department of Management Sciences before September each year.*

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote a caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via the CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.
