Noteworthy areas of expertise include predicting stock returns, formulating and executing asset-pricing tests, investing with a focus on Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) considerations, comprehending financial market anomalies, and exploring investment strategies in mutual and hedge funds. Professor Avramov's research also delves into financial econometrics, stock-return autocorrelation, volatility, and liquidity. His scholarly contributions include publications featured in Journal of Financial Economics, Review of Financial Studies, Financial Analyst Journal, Journal of Investing, Journal of Business, Journal of Finance, Annual Review of Financial Economics, Journal of Banking and Finance, and Journal of Financial Markets.
